## D.EL.Ed Question Pattern

- Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ) you'll have 20 MCQ. Each question carry 1 mark. 1\*20=20
- Short Type Question. You'll have 12 alternative questions, among them you'll have to solve 10 questions. Each question carry 2 marks. 2\*10=20
- Long Type Questions-you'll have 3 questions, among them only 2 you'll have to do. Each question carry 7 marks. 7\*2=14
- Very Long Type questions You'll have 2 questions among them you'll have to do only 1. Each question carry 16 marks.
